ADDITIONAL TICKETS AND REGISTRATIONS

Extra personnel required to staff the exhibition stand must purchase additional exhibitor registrations at \$550 which includes:

APPLIANCE TESTING

All electrical appliances and leads used on site must comply with the Australian Standard AS/NZ 3760:2010, which requires the appliance to be inspected, tested and tagged. Items that do not comply will not be permitted to be used onsite.

Electrical items such as switchboards, cables and outlet fittings must comply with the Australian electrical wiring standard AS/NZS 3000:2007 and be installed by a qualified A grade electrician. Note: Double adaptors will not be permitted onsite, instead power boards with overload cut off are permitted.
